

Crocker Community Storm Shelter

The Crocker R-II School District is pleased to be able to provide a Community Storm Shelter for the safety of the community and school.

The shelter is open anytime there is a "Severe Thunderstorm Warning" or a "Tornado Warning" issued by The National Weather Service for northern Pulaski County. It will not always be available when there is a "Severe Thunderstorm Watch" or "Tornado Watch" only.

There are signs on the school campus to point the way to the shelter entrances. It is recommended to park in the rear parking lot and come in the back entrance to the Gym/Cafeteria/Shelter.

The Community Storm Shelter was constructed through a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Department of Homeland Security.
